Dear FCC:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act 5 U.S.C. § 552.

I request access to and copies of records relating to each instance in which FCC Chairman Kevin Martin has traveled to the state of North Carolina using any government resources (financial or otherwise) since he became Commissioner on July 3, 2001.

Please provide records indicating the date, duration, and purpose of each of Chairman Martin's trip to North Carolina.

Please provide all records indicating the individuals or organizations with whom Chairman Martin met during his visit to North Carolina and furnish copies of his itinerary, public schedule and/or meeting minutes.

If any taxpayer resources were used to support Chairman Martin's trip to North Carolina, please provide records indicating the cost of such resources (including receipts or records for airfare, lodging, expenses, staff time, or otherwise).

Because this request pertains only to the Chairman's travel for which taxpayer resources (financial or otherwise) have been used – and there is clearly a public benefit to knowing how taxpayer funds are being used for travel by agency heads – none of these requests should be denied based on Exemption 6 of 5 U.S.C. § 552 (the "clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy").

I agree to incur fees of not more than \$1,000 for the cost of searching for and reproducing records that are responsive to this request. If you estimate the search charges are likely to exceed \$1,000, please notify me of the estimated fee prior to searching.

If you deny any part of this request, please cite each specific reason that you think justifies your refusal to release the information and notify me of appeal procedures available to me under the law.
